Create living landscapes that support health, wellbeing, and connection—where both people and nature can thrive.



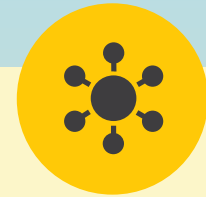
## Integrated Landscape and Program Design
